#### Application Components

Narrative Ideal performance measures format in the

- Table is great, but must be accompanied with a written narrative
- Should include time horizon (e.g. "within 3 years of project completion")
- Narrative should define what is meant by "served" and "improved"
- Narrative should describe how outcomes will be measured







#### Examples

Performance Measure	Projected Value	Description
Businesses Served (output)	15	Provide technical assistance during the project period.
Businesses Improved (outcome)	10	Businesses improved within 3 years of project completion. See additional details in narrative below.
Jobs created(outcome)	30	Jobs created within 3 years of project completion.
Leveraged Private Investment (outcome)	\$3,000,000	LPI from XYZ company during the project period. See attached letter.
Businesses Created (outcome)	ω	New agri-businesses created within 3 years of project completion.



# Tips for Workforce / Education Measures

Participants	Workers/Trainees	Students	Measure
Attendees at a conference, workshop, or field trip where it would be difficult to track improvements resulting from attendance.	Those developing job skills and NOT in a diploma or degree seeking program.	Those working towards a diploma or degree.	Definition



# Tips for Workforce / Education Measures

Type of Student	Definition of Improvement
Adults and postsecondary students	Obtain employment, earn diploma, certification to perform job activities, etc.
Secondary students	Obtain employment, or are still enrolled in education (at the same school or another institution).
Least preferred type of improvershop/unit of study/course.	Least preferred type of improvement: Successful completion of a workshop/unit of study/course.



## Tips for Business Development Measures

Businesses Improved	Businesses Served / Improved	Jobs Retained	Measure
Improvement = growth in sales/profit, acquired new capital, expanded employment, new facility, launched new product/service.	Usually the number of improved is less than the number served and that is OK.	Only applies when ARC investment has a critical role in preventing job loss. Applicants should provide supporting documentation.	Tip



#### Tips for Water / Sewer Measures

Measure	Tip
	All non-residential customers are considered businesses
Households and Businesses	If the project is a system-wide improvement, it's OK to count all businesses/households in the system
	Served = number that could connect to service Improved = number that will hook up to service
Jobs Created/Retained, LPI	Jobs Created/Retained, Committing to create/retain jobs or make LPI



#### Tips for Broadband Measures

Served = number that could connect to service  Businesses / Households   Improved = number that will subscribe to service	Businesses / Household:
Number of locations where wireless broadband equipment is installed (e.g. radio towers)	Telecom Sites
Linear feet of fiber being deployed	Linear Feet
New maximum capacity of a network or storage facility	MBPS and TB

- 8. No measures at all!
- Measures aren't ones that we use
- 6. Activities are listed as measures
- Measures are listed as percentages
- 4. No documentation from employers about jobs / LPI
- 3. No explanation of how outcomes will be measured
- Paired measures aren't paired
- 1. Measures aren't specific / described in detail
