## USDA Offering Grants to Assist Communities with Water or Wastewater Systems Management

The <u>US Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Technical Assistance and Training (TAT) Grant Program</u> assists communities with water or wastewater systems through free technical assistance and/or training provided to the grant recipients. Qualified private non-profit organizations will receive TAT grant funds to identify and evaluate solutions to water and waste disposal problems in rural areas, assist applicants in preparing applications for water and wastewater grants made at the state level offices, and improve operation and maintenance of existing water and wastewater disposal facilities in rural areas.

Funds may be used to pay expenses associated with providing technical assistance and/or training (TAT) to identify and evaluate solutions to water problems relating to source, storage, treatment, and distribution, and to

waste disposal problems relating to collection, treatment, and disposal; assist applicants that have filed a preapplication with the Rural Utilities Service (RUS) in the preparation of water and/or waste disposal loan and/or grant applications; and to provide training that will improve the management, operation and maintenance of water and wastewater disposal facilities.

All applications must be received by close of business or postmarked by midnight January 31st.
