### River Park Program at Allegany County Museum

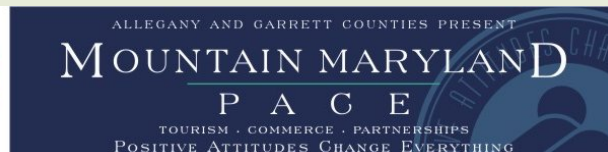
