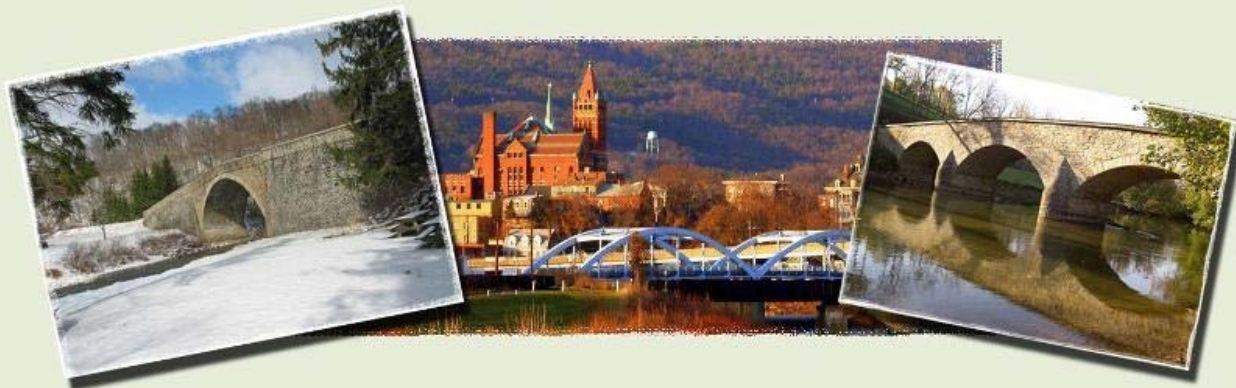

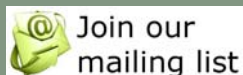


Road To Recovery®

5310 Grant Applications

The Maryland Department of Transportation/Maryland Transit Administration (MDOT/MTA) is pleased to announce the availability of funding from the U.S. Department of Transportation /Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for Section 5310-Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities capital funds for Non-Profit Organizations and the availability of State funds for the Senior Rides Program (SRP).

ELIGIBLE SECTION 5310 APPLICANTS

Private, non-profit entities and faith-based agencies that provide transportation services to disabled and elderly individuals and are exempt from taxation under § 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code are eligible to receive funding.

ELIGIBLE SECTION 5310 PROJECTS

Section 5310 Program grant funds are available for capital and operating expenses to support the provision of transportation services to meet the specific needs of

seniors and individuals with disabilities. At least 55% of Section 5310 funds will be used for "traditional" capital projects.
