

Grants of \$1,000 to \$5,000 are provided to nonprofit organizations that provide opportunities for youth participation in the following areas: 1) youth athletic programs, with emphasis on community-based programs addressing active lifestyles and team building skills; and 2) established camps that focus on sports and active lifestyles, with emphasis on programs serving disadvantaged and special needs kids. POWER (Partnerships for Opportunity and Workforce and Economic Revitalization) Grants

In FY16, ARC (Appalachian Regional Commission) is providing POWER implementation grants and technical assistance grants for activities that address the challenges facing coal-impacted communities in the Appalachian Region. Continuum of Care Program Notice of Funding Availability

The **Continuum of Care (CoC) Program** is designed to promote a community-wide commitment to the goal of ending homelessness; to provide funding for efforts by nonprofit providers, states, and local governments to quickly re-house homeless individuals and families while minimizing the trauma and dislocation caused to homeless individuals, families, and communities by homelessness; to promote access to and effective utilization of mainstream programs by homeless individuals and families; and to optimize self-sufficiency among individuals and families experiencing homelessness.

The deadline for submitting new and renewal project applications in e-snaps for **Cumberland/Allegany County MD Continuum of Care (MD-500)** is **August 21, 2016**, to ensure all projects are rated and ranked prior to the deadline for submitting applications to HUD for the FY 2015 CoC Program Competition, which is September 14, 2016, at 7:59:59 PM EST.
