MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION MARYLAND TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION MARYLAND SENIOR RIDES PROGRAM FUNDING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 ANNOUNCEMENT

In anticipation of receiving state funds for the Maryland Senior Rides Demonstration Program (SRDP) in July 2017 the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) Office of Local Transit Support (OLTS) is now accepting applications for grant funding. The primary focus of this program is to encourage and facilitate the development of volunteer transportation services for low-income to moderate-income seniors. To be eligible, a program applicant must be a government agency, non-profit entity, or tax-exempt faith-based agency that provides transportation services. Grants awarded will require a 25% funding match minimum. Funding match above the 25% minimum could possibly increase your chances of a grant award.

The MTA will host a series of informational meetings around the State to distribute applications and to answer any questions regarding the program. Locations include
