Notice of Funding Availability

MD SENIOR RIDES PROGRAM FUNDING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 MD DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION MD TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION Application Deadline Reminder

In anticipation of receiving state funds for the Maryland Senior Rides Demonstration Program (SRDP) in July 2017 the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) Office of Local Transit Support (OLTS) is now accepting applications for grant funding. The primary focus of this program is to encourage and facilitate the development of volunteer transportation services for low-income to moderate-income seniors. To be eligible, a program applicant must be a government agency, non-profit entity, or tax-exempt faith-based agency that provides transportation services. Grants awarded will require a 25% funding match minimum. Funding match above the 25% minimum could possibly increase your chances of a grant award.

In order to be considered for this funding cycle application must be submitted to MTA no later than **Friday, April 14, 2017**.
