#### SBA 7a Loans

Providing loans to small businesses (including small healthcare practices) for working capital; equipment purchase; real estate purchase; building construction or renovation; business acquisition; and debt refinancing. Applications accepted on an ongoing basis.

## USDA Water and Waste Disposal Loan and Grant Program

Eunding for clean and reliable drinking water systems, sanitary sewage disposal, sanitary solid waste disposal, and storm water drainage to households and businesses in eligible rural areas.
