USDA Rural Development's Rural Business Development Grant (RBDG) Program is a competitive grant designed to support targeted technical assistance, training, and other activities leading to the development or expansion of small and emerging private businesses in rural areas, which will employ 50 or fewer new employees and has less than \$1 million in gross revenue. Application Deadline is March 29, 2019


Interested applicants should download the RBDG Application Guide. Submitted applications will be scored, reviewed, and selected on a competitive basis.
