### Congressman Trone Announces \$170 Million in Funding for the Appalachian Regional Commission

*Funding includes an increase of \$5 million from  
previous year's budget*

Congressman David Trone (MD-06) recently announced \$170 million in funding for the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC), an increase of \$5 million from the previous year's funding from Congress.

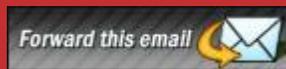
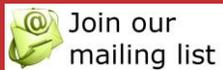
ARC funds projects in the Appalachian Region to promote economic development, education and job training, critical infrastructure, and community development. This funding includes \$10 million to develop workforce reentry strategies for those recovering from a substance use disorder and \$10 million to spur high-speed broadband deployment.

"Over the past six months, I heard from so many people in Western Maryland about the importance of the Appalachian Regional Commission. That's why I'm happy to announce that this year we secured additional funding for this economic development engine," said Congressman Trone. "ARC funding helps create thousands of new jobs, support those in recovery from substance abuse, and invest in broadband and infrastructure to secure the long-term success of the region."
