Identify the transportation needs of individuals with disabilities, older adults, and people with low incomes, and provide strategies for meeting local needs.

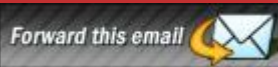
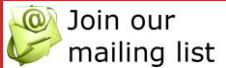
Prioritize transportation services and projects for funding and implementation.

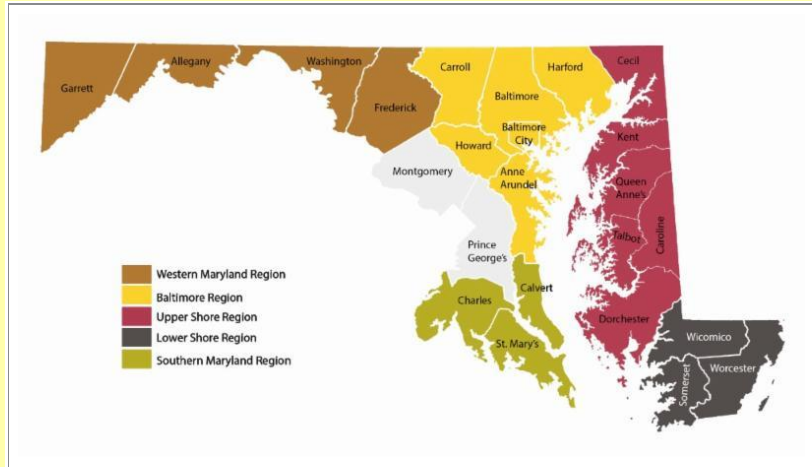
