Applications Now Open for Senator George C. Edwards Fund for Western Maryland

The Tri-County Council for Western Maryland recently announced that applications are now open for the Senator George C. Edwards Fund for Western Maryland. The fund, overseen by the 11-member Western Maryland Economic Future Investment Board and administered by the Tri-County Council, will provide loan and grant assistance to Washington, Allegany, and Garrett counties for economic development projects. \$50 million has been allocated over four years, with \$20 million available in FY2023 and \$10 million each in FY2024, FY2025, and FY2026.
