Register today for the **MDOT** in Motion: Strategizing for Transportation Trails Webinar on September 4 at 11:30 a.m.! This webinar is open to the public, transportation practitioners, employers, and anyone who is interested in learning more about this topic.

MDOT in Motion is a series of webinars, interactive sessions, and educational opportunities offered by the Maryland Department of Transportation's (MDOT) Office of Active Transportation and Micromobility. The series highlights multi-modal projects and programs that are designed to get Marylanders moving safely, and to connect them to opportunities and to each other. In Maryland, Complete Streets is the deliberate approach to planning and designing streets for all users, MDOT in Motion demonstrates opportunities to make options like walking, biking, and transit more accessible.

The September 4 webinar will explore transportation trails and how community members can be involved from building support to reaping the benefits. At the

webinar, MDOT will unveil the 2025 Maryland Statewide Transportation Trails
Strategic Plan and interactive website. Guest speaker Greg Lawson will showcase
resources from Rails to Trails Conservancy, with a spotlight on their Baltimore
Greenways Trails Coalition. Jeffrey Simcoe, Executive Director of the Frostburg
Outdoor Recreation Economy Institute (FOREI) and Great Alleghany Passage (GAP)
Conservancy board member, will speak to the impact that the GAP, an established and
maintained trail, has on the economies of small and rural communities in western
Maryland.



Maryland Coordinated Transportation Planning Workshops and Focus Groups

On behalf of the Maryland Department of Transportation's Maryland Transit Administration (MDOT MTA) the KFH Group invites you to participate in the update of the Maryland Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plans. These regional plans identify the transportation needs of individuals with disabilities, older adults, and people with low incomes; provide strategies for meeting local needs; and prioritize transportation services and projects for funding and implementation.

Importantly, the plans serve as the basis for funding through MDOT MTA's Section 5310 (Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities) Program, as future projects funded through this program will be derived from the updated plans. Therefore, current Section 5310 Program subrecipients and prospective applicants for future funding are required to be involved in the planning process.

Input from you and a wide range of stakeholders is a key component in the update of the Coordinated Transportation Plans, and therefore regional workshops and focus groups have been scheduled across the state.
